<i>Old Student ID Number</i>	<b>X0631328005</b> <small>Student ID Number</small>	Student ID cards (7 digits), old student ID cards (with the x and the 10 numbers) and staff ID cards for Box Hill Institute. The first two digits are the year of enrolment for students and for the staff when began employment. If the next two numbers are 99 it means they are an international student.

Chisholm Institute	200707158	The Chisholm format of student id is the year eg. 2008 or 2007 then another sequence of no.s.
Deakin University	X01124005784173	Format of Library ID number for members of Deakin University is 14 characters, beginning X011. IDs beginning X01150 are staff numbers.
East Gippsland Institute of TAFE	WEA65478329	First three letters of the student's name and then 8 numbers.
Environment Protection Agency	5502	Numbers are assigned in consecutive numerical order with no proceeding alpha letters.
GippsTAFE	BRI50201397, POU02222895, MIL06258935	First 3 letters of the students surname followed by 8 digits.
Gordon Institute of TAFE		
<i>Student</i>	BUR04048618, DAR08023886	The Gordon Institute of TAFE Library has student ID numbers in the following pattern : the first 3 letters of the student's surname eg. BUR for Burton then 8 numbers which reflect the first year of enrolment eg. BUR04048618 04 signifies that this student was enrolled in 2004 ; DAR08023886 signifies that this student was enrolled in 2008.
<i>Staff</i>	37536	
		The Gordon has actually been stamping CAVAL cards with a very small Gordon stamp (stamped just below the borrower's Student / Staff number). Thus their patrons go to other libraries with CAVAL cards which designate the Gordon as home institution.

	RUD08251546, JAC01047375, HOW94007062	At Holmesglen, student ID numbers are prefixed with the first three letters of a students family name followed by eight numbers. The first two numbers represent the year that they originally enrolled.
	NGC03101704	If the student has a family name that only has two letter to it, the first initial of their given name is added to the other two letters and followed by eight digit number.

<i>Student</i>	<b>TUN86865197</b>	A student id has the KBT name and logo, student id, expiry date, surname and first name, their photo and the barcode. Student id is 2/3 letters of surname, followed by 7-10 digits, the first two digits being original year of enrolment.
<i>Staff</i>	<b>021054</b>	A staff id will definitely have staff first name, and sometimes surname, KBT name and logo, staff photo, barcode, with staff 6 digit ID number underneath.

<i>Albury/Wodonga Campus</i>	<b>2 3690 00027137 0</b>	La Trobe barcodes do not have any specific format. These have been a batch of generic patron barcodes used for many years. At Bundoora staff recognise the beginning 3 numbers "999" as CAVAL borrowers.

<i>Bundoora Campus</i>	<b>C 99931 1842 B</b>	
Monash University	01XXXXXX	Monash University ID numbers are usually eight digit numbers with a leading zero, for example 01XXXXXX. (Staff ID numbers, if they do not write down all the leading zeros, could be fewer than eight digits if they are long-standing members because it has been a progressive number over the years.) Most current staff IDs will commence with '1'. Most current student IDs now commence with '2' but some could still commence with '1', in both cases without a leading zero. However, some students at the Gippsland campus may have ID numbers commencing with '9'.

Northern Melbourne Institute of TAFE	0800354, 0506354	NMIT student numbers are always 7 digits in length. The first 2 digits represent the first year that the student enrolled at NMIT. The last 5 numbers have no intrinsic relevance, purely sequential. A student enrolling at NMIT for the first time in 2008 would have a number such as 0800354. A returning student will have a number from the their first year here, such as 0506354 for a student who was originally enrolled in 2005.

<i>Student IDs since 2002</i>	7 digits, usually starting with 3... eg. 3192462, 3203713 3179723, 3114231, 3081087	The majority of RMIT students have a 7 digit number that starts with 3, either 30 or 31 depending on what year they enrolled (eg. 3012547 or 3165472).
<i>Prior to 2002</i>	7 digits followed by check letter, starting with two figures indicating year... eg. 9002922K, 8601028T, 9601118X, 9999810J, 7500234D	Older or previous students may have a 7 digit number that began with the last two numbers of the actual enrolment year, and included a letter at the end. Some of these still exist (eg. 2034515B).
South West Institute of TAFE	SMI12345678	SMI (1st 3 letters of surname), 12345678 (8 digit number)

	1234567	ID number for students and staff is 7 digits. e.g. 1234567 Some ID's may have the letter X for the last digit. e.g.123456X
<i>Student</i>	U3123456X	Library barcode for students.
<i>Staff</i>	U01234567	Library barcode for staff.
University of Ballarat		
<i>Higher Ed Students</i>	2657421, 2825198, 2350649	7 digit ID number.
<i>Higher Ed Staff</i>	04120, 07729	6 digit ID number.
<i>TAFE Students</i>	281635, 162491	5 digit ID number.

<i>Recent Student number</i>	235684	Recent students have 6 digits with no spaces.
<i>Older Student number</i>	198236458	Some students with older student numbers will have 9 digits with no spaces. The extra 3 digits will be at the start of the number and will be 19X (X corresponds to which decade they became a student eg. 8 for 1980).
Victoria University	3668601, 3577380	Student ID number formats are 7 digits.
William Angliss Institute	SMI08123456, JON07234561	The student number begins with the first 3 letters of the surname, followed by the year of enrolment, and then followed by six random numbers.
